

UPDATE ON CLUB RESTORATION Generous members have donated \$91,172 and the club has spent every cent of it

to get our 5,000 square foot club reopened. Considering we've installed a new 25-year roof; new inside ceiling; rebuilt and restored our vintage dance floor; ground and polished our terrazzo floor; put in a new kitchen fridge; built a concrete barrier to prevent flooding from parking lot runoff; replaced outside

lighting and rewired outdated parts of the club (much of which isn't immediately

obvious); refurbished, refitted and sealed our brass bar rail; replaced all emergency lighting and recertified our fire safety systems; repaired our pulley system on both flagpoles which haven't worked in nearly a decade...and more....we have gotten tremendous value out of your donations! In fact, we have gotten discounts or donated labor worth in excess of \$20,000, as well. Our fundraising continues, as our aging building still needs work to ensure it will serve members well into the future. Case in point: Two weeks ago, one of our four old air conditioners gave up and needed replacement. We hurried to replace it just 48 hours before we had a crowd of over 200 for Dyngus Day! The cost

Saturday, May 3 at 10:00 a.m. at Williams Park, St. Petersburg




